A NOTE FOR PARENTS: Each day's city focus is shared with the adult PURSUE guide, so the whole family can be praying together – children and adults – for the same part of the world.

They are God's First Chosen Family

A long time ago, God chose a man named
Abraham and promised to build a great family
through him – the Jewish people. God said He
would bless Abraham's family, and that through
them, He would bless every nation on earth!

Jesus Was Jewish

Jesus – the Saviour of the whole world – was
born Jewish, in the Jewish town of Bethlehem,
to a Jewish family. He grew up reading the
Hebrew Scriptures, celebrating Jewish festivals,
and teaching in Jewish synagogues. When we
love Jesus, we are loving someone from this
remarkable family!

God's Promises Still Stand

The Bible tells us that God's gifts and His calling
can never be taken back (Romans 11:29). God
still loves the Jewish people deeply, and He has
promised that one day, "all Israel will be saved"
(Romans 11:26) – meaning many Jewish people
will recognise Jesus as their Messiah.

We Pray Because We Love Them

Just like we pray for children in cities who have
never heard about Jesus, we also pray for our
Jewish friends around the world – in Israel and in
every nation – that they would come to
know Jesus, the Messiah who loves them
and gave His life for them.

have never once heard the name of Jesus. Not once! Can you imagine that?

So when we pray for these cities, we're not just saying words. We're asking God to send His love there – through missionaries, through churches, through ordinary families just like yours – so that kids everywhere can know how much Jesus loves them. That's what being on mission for Jesus looks like – even from your own bedroom, even at age six, even at age twelve.

And there's one more really special thing we do. Every day, we also pray for the Jewish people – in Israel and all around the world. Do you know why? Because Jesus was Jewish! His family, His friends, His whole upbringing – Jewish. The Jewish people are God's first chosen family, and the Bible promises that God still loves them and hasn't forgotten His promises to them. So we pray that more and more Jewish people would come to know Jesus as their Messiah – the One their own Scriptures pointed to all along.

So that's it – that's Following Jesus! Ten days, ten stories, ten cities, one big prayer for the whole world including God's first family the Jewish people, and ten days of becoming 2BC Champions – Hearing, Knowing, and Sharing!

Grab your Bible, grab your family, and get ready to sing our theme song about a hundred times – you'll know it by heart by Day Three, I promise!

I cannot wait to do this with you. Let's go follow Jesus together – step by step, every single day. See you on Day One!



Hi everyone! I'm Cami, I'm thirteen years old – my family is American, but I was actually born here in Paris, France, and it's home! I am SO excited because you are about to start the BEST ten days ever. Welcome to Following Jesus!

So what actually is this guide? Over the next ten days, we're going to read ten amazing Bible stories – stories about kindness, courage, friendship, truth, and a whole lot more – and every single one teaches us something about what it really means to follow Jesus. Step by step. Every day.

Each day you'll get a story, a memory verse, fun activities, a family challenge, a colouring page, some awesome worship music – and a little video from me! I'll be right here with you the whole way.

This guide is made with our friends at [2BC](#) – that's 2 Billion Children – and they believe something amazing:

that children, just like you, have the power to change the world! Not when you're grown up. Now! 2BC's big dream is for children EVERYWHERE to be on mission for Jesus.

So all through this guide, we're going to learn to be what 2BC calls Champions – and that just means three simple things: Hearing from our Heavenly Father, Knowing why we're special to Him, and Sharing His love with our friends and family. Hearing, Knowing, Sharing. Easy to remember, right?

Now, I want to tell you about something really special we're doing in this guide. Every single day, we're also going to pray for a real city, somewhere in the world. Some of these cities are huge – like Paris, where I live, or Mumbai, or Mexico City. Others you might never have heard of, like Yangon or Ulaanbaatar or Tashkent. No! It's only made me work harder and harder.

Let me be honest with you, occasionally yes.

I might get frustrated, tired and a little discouraged with my situation.

So what do I usually do? Breathe, rest and relax

More about Justin...

Justin was diagnosed with autism at two. He was unable to speak until five. He underwent 40 hours of therapy weekly. He was not accepted by 15 schools before finally finding one. At seven, his writing skill was assessed at just 0.1 percent, but his mother's efforts to teach him how to hold a pencil and write bore fruit. By eight, Justin's writing was published by a national publisher.

Despite his challenges with speaking and battles with his autism, Justin uses his writing to inspire and encourage others worldwide, turning his challenges into a source of strength. A Note for Parents and Guardians

This guide is designed to be used in whatever format fits your family – there are no rules! Each day's video and prayer guide content can be used flexibly, dipped into together or separately, in whatever order works best for you.

You might watch Cami's video at breakfast and save the activity for after school, or do everything together at bedtime – it's entirely up to you. Designed to take just 5–10 minutes each day in full, it's easy to build a simple, meaningful rhythm of prayer into family life without any pressure.

The aim is not perfection, but consistency and joy as your child learns to connect with God and discover what it means to follow Jesus – step by step, every day.

Encourage your child to read aloud, engage with the Bible verse, and try saying it in their own words. The short prayers are there to help, but don't feel limited by them—invite your child to talk to God freely and naturally, just as they would speak to a loving Father.

Each day includes a theme to help children grow as 2BC Champions—learning to HEAR God's voice, KNOW their identity in Him, and SHARE His love with others. You may want to pause and ask simple questions, allowing space for reflection and conversation.

The worship songs, including the "Follow Jesus!" theme song, are a wonderful way to engage energy and creativity—encourage your children to add actions, movement, and joy as they worship.

Above all, keep it relaxed, expect God to speak, and enjoy this journey together as a family. Small, faithful moments of prayer can shape a child's life forever.

In John 8:12, Jesus said: "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

Last summer, we launched SHINE! – it involves many children around the world joining together each month in 24 Hours of Worship and Prayer. For one whole day, every hour, children and families pray and

worship, asking God to use the new animated film Light of the World to touch the hearts of millions of children. Each month, we will focus on a country – praying for the children and youth to become Jesus followers!

You can join us from home, school, church or online for SHINE! each month during 2026. We meet on the second Tuesday of each month!

The Light of the World movie tells the story of Jesus through the eyes of his youngest Apostle, John, when he is a child and a follower of Jesus. It has just launched in theaters in the U.S. and in several other nations.

TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL

Have you ever walked past someone who needed help? Maybe you weren't sure what to do, or you were in a hurry. In Jesus' day, a man was walking down a dangerous road when robbers attacked him and left him badly hurt. Two important religious people walked by – and did nothing. But then a Samaritan came along. Samaritans and Jewish people didn't usually get along, so nobody expected him to stop. But he did! He bandaged the man's wounds, put him on his own donkey, took him to an inn, and even paid for his care.

Jesus told this story to answer a big question: "Who is my neighbour?" The answer? Everyone who needs help is our neighbour! Jesus doesn't just want us to love the people who are like us, or the people we already know. He wants us to cross the road, stop what we're doing, and choose to be kind – even when it's hard.

Today, ask God to give you eyes that notice people who need help. Because following Jesus means choosing kindness every single day.

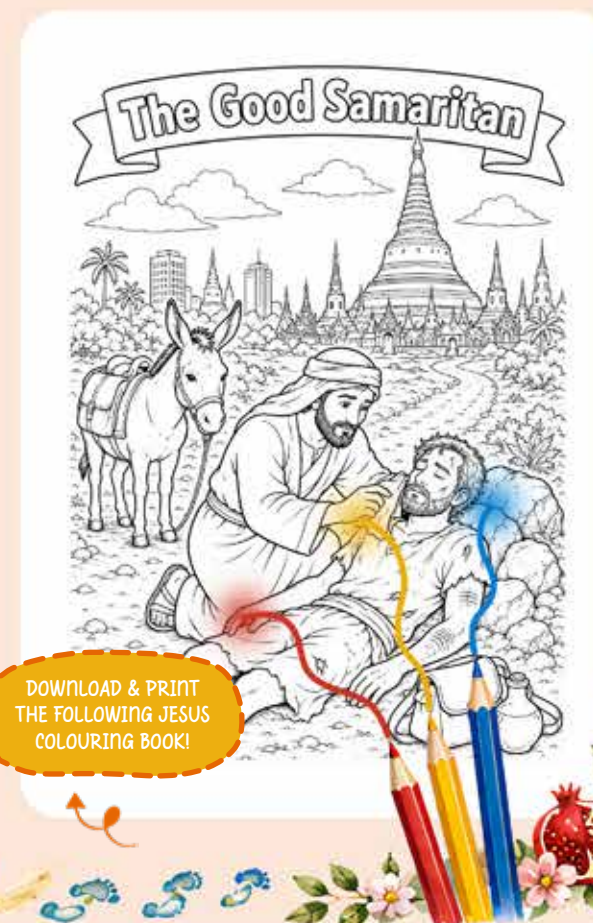

TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL

Imagine being the most unpopular kid in town – everyone knows your name, but NOT in a good way. That was Zacchaeus. He was a tax collector who cheated people out of their money, and everyone knew it. He was also very short, which is why when Jesus came to town, he had to climb a sycamore tree just to see over the crowd.

But here's the amazing part: Jesus spotted him up in that tree – and called him by name! "Zacchaeus, come down! I'm staying at your house today." The crowd was shocked. Why would Jesus want to spend time with THAT man?

But that one moment changed everything. Sitting with Jesus, Zacchaeus felt something shift inside him. He stood up and said, "I'll give half my money to the poor – and if I've cheated anyone, I'll pay them back four times over!" Jesus said: "Salvation has come to this house today!"

Jesus doesn't wait until we're perfect to come close. He sees us – even up in our trees – and calls us by name. When we spend time with Jesus, He changes our hearts from the inside out. That's what a clean heart looks like: letting Jesus in, and letting Him make things right.

Pray: Lord, change hearts in Ulaanbaatar like You changed Zacchaeus – completely, joyfully, forever.

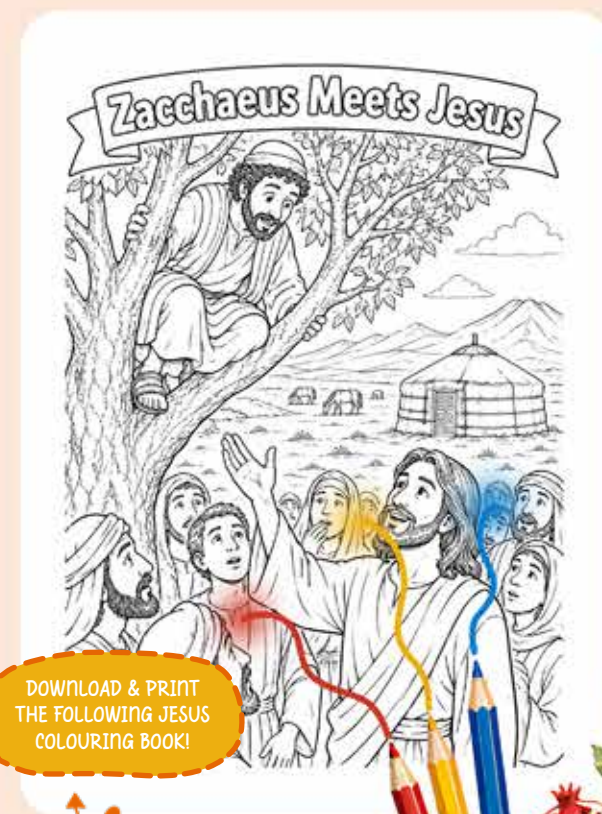
JUSTIN'S THOUGHTS

TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL

Ruth and Naomi didn't look like they belonged together. Naomi was an older Jewish woman whose husband and sons had died, leaving her heartbroken and alone. Ruth was her daughter-in-law from a completely different country and culture. When Naomi decided to travel home to Bethlehem, she told Ruth: "Go back to your own people. You don't have to come with me."

But Ruth wouldn't leave. She said those unforgettable words: "Where you go I will go. Where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God will be my God." Ruth chose love over comfort. She chose family over familiarity.

God's family is like that. It's not made up of people who all look the same, speak the same language, or come from the same place. God's family stretches across every nation, every culture, every colour. When we follow Jesus, we become brothers and sisters with people all over the world – even people we've never met!

You are part of the most international, most wonderfully mixed-up, most beautiful family on earth. And just like Ruth, God asks us to stick together – across every difference – because that's what love does. It stays.

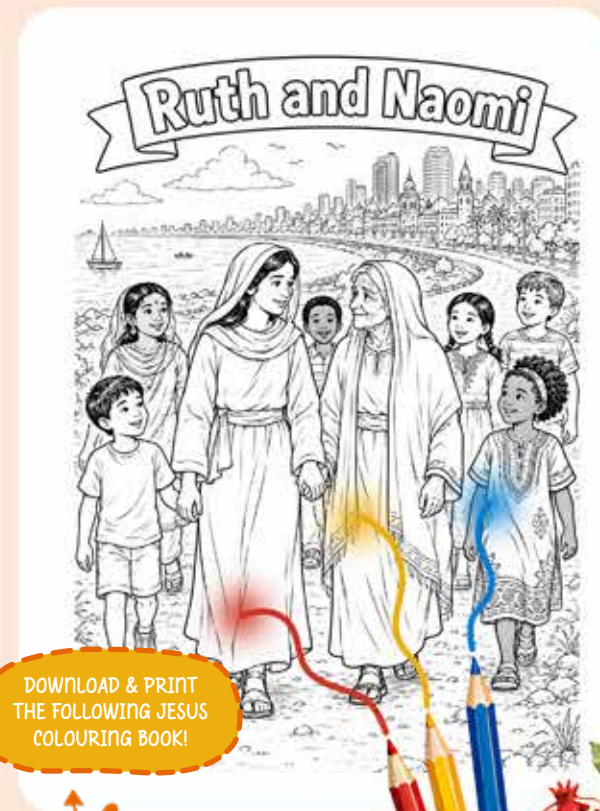

TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL

Jacob and Esau were twin brothers, but their story was anything but peaceful. Jacob had tricked their father and stolen Esau's blessing, and Esau was so furious he wanted to kill his brother. Jacob ran away and didn't come back for twenty years.

Then one day, Jacob heard that Esau was coming to meet him – with four hundred men. Jacob was terrified. He prayed, he sent gifts ahead, and he prepared for the worst. But when Esau finally saw Jacob, something incredible happened. Esau ran. Not to fight – but to hug. He threw his arms around his brother, and they both wept. God had been working in both their hearts.

You might know what it's like to fall out with someone – a friend, a sibling, someone at school. Maybe it's been going on so long, it feels impossible to fix. But Jesus is the ultimate peacemaker. He gave His life to break down walls and bring people back together. And He invites us to be peacemakers too.

Being a peacemaker doesn't mean pretending nothing happened. It means being brave enough to take the first step – like Jacob walking towards Esau, bowing low, hoping for forgiveness. Real peace costs something. But it is always, always worth it.

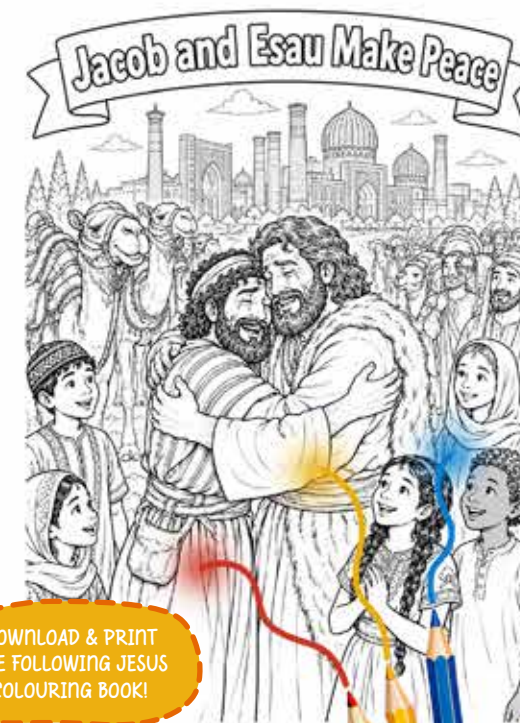

TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL

Josiah became king when he was just EIGHT years old. Can you imagine? Eight! While most kids his age were playing in the streets, Josiah was responsible for an entire nation. And unlike many kings before him, Josiah chose to follow God with his whole heart.

One day, workers repairing the temple found something incredible – a scroll. It was the Book of God's Law that had been lost and forgotten for years. When it was read aloud to Josiah, he was so moved that he tore his robes in grief. He realised how far his nation had wandered from God's ways.

But Josiah didn't just feel sad and do nothing. He acted. He called everyone together, read God's Word aloud to the whole nation, and led a massive clean-up – removing all the idols and false altars from the land. He put God first, even when it was hard work.

You might not be a king or queen, but you have something just as powerful: the choice to put God first every day. Maybe that means reading your Bible, or choosing God's way even when everyone else chooses differently. Like Josiah, you can be young and still make a massive difference when you choose: King First.

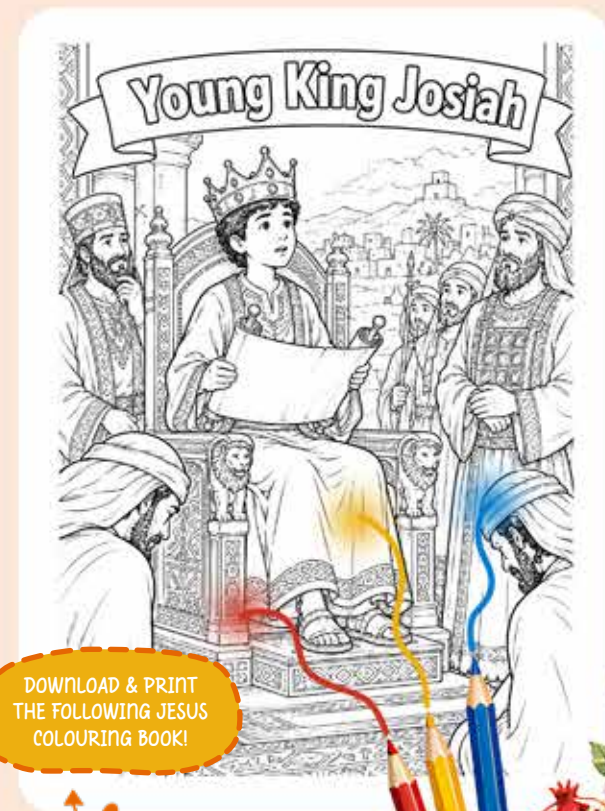

TODAY'S DEVOTIONAL

Daniel was a teenager when his world was turned upside down. He'd been taken from his home in Jerusalem and brought to Babylon, one of the most powerful cities on earth. The king wanted to train him as one of his officials – a great opportunity. But there was a catch.

Daniel was expected to eat the king's food and drink the king's wine. And Daniel knew that this food didn't honour God. So he made a brave decision. He politely but firmly said: "No thank you. Could we eat vegetables and water instead, and see how we look after ten days?"

The official was nervous – but agreed. Ten days later, Daniel and his three friends looked healthier than everyone else in the king's programme. And God gave Daniel wisdom and understanding beyond anyone around him.

Here's what's amazing: Daniel didn't make a loud fuss. He didn't shout or rebel. He simply made a quiet, firm choice to honour God – even when it was easier not to. And God honoured him for it.

You face moments like this too. Maybe it's not about food – maybe it's about what you watch, how you speak about others, or whether you tell the truth when it would be easier to lie. Following Jesus means choosing truth, even when it costs you something. And when you do, God shows up.

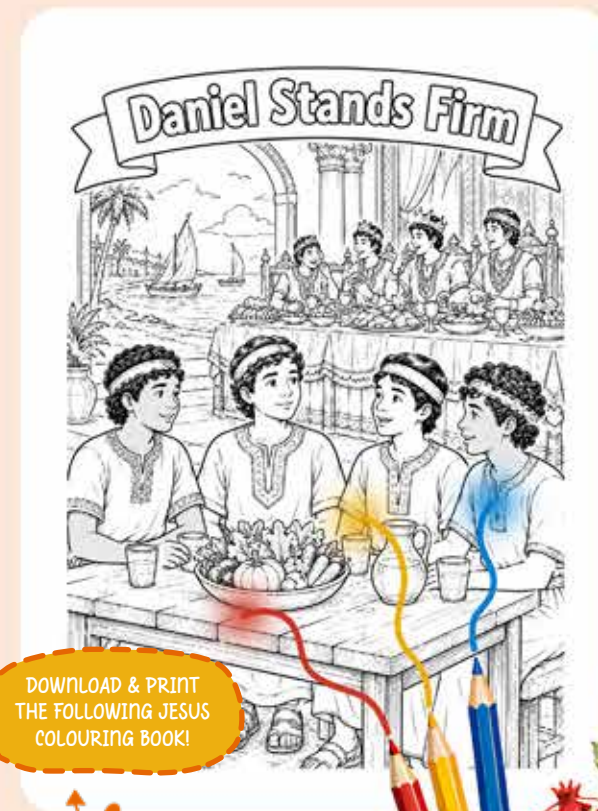

It's about making sure that in all the busyness of life, you keep coming back to His feet. Keep listening. Keep choosing the one thing that matters most: staying close to the one who loves you most.

When we put what we have into Jesus' hands – even if it seems small, even if it seems not enough – He can do more with it than we can imagine.

Sharing Jesus works the same way. Maybe you think: "I'm just a kid. What can I do?" But you can smile at someone who's lonely. You can tell a friend what Jesus means to you. You can pray for your school, your street, your city. You can give what you've got to Jesus – and watch what He does with it.

The harvest is full of people waiting to be found. And Jesus invites you to be part of it.

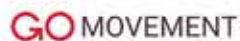
